Requirements:

The poster will include the following information:

- Title
- Clear Subheadings will vary according to your chosen topic
- Explanation of your topic in detail (5 w's)
- Select a focal question within your topic and provide additional research
- Include a minimum of 3 images that align with your research (be sure to create a caption for each)
- Include your personal opinion/reflection on your topic
- Map indicating where your Indigenous Peoples or focus is located
- References (may be glued to the back of the poster)
 - include at least three (3) different sources (no Wikipedia)
 - be sure to follow the Works Cited guide (MLA style) on the Oak Bay High website
